日米薬学会合同シンポジウム：創薬の新しい流れ

PSJ-AAPS Joint Symposium: New Trends of Medicinal Chemistry

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Pharmaceutical Society, Japan (PSJ) and American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists (AAPS) organize a Joint Symposium biannually at the site of each annual meeting for exchanging knowledge and networking. This year, four lectures will focus on topics on a new trend of medicinal chemistry from the view points of practical and theoretical aspects. Dr. Yoshihiko Kotake (Eisai Co, Ltd.) will present a chemical approaches to an antitumor natural product pladienolide, and Dr. Yoshiaki Kiso (Kyoto Pharmaceutical University) will review their challenging approaches for difficult diseases. In contrast to talks on new drugs by Japanese speakers, Dr. Nicholas Bodor (University of Florida) will describe retrometabolic drug design and Dr. Buchwald Peter (University of Miami) will focus on role of molecular size of drugs. The organizers expect that this joint symposium will contribute to mutual understanding of the members of PSJ and AAPS as well as to developments of medicinal chemistry.
