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FIP/BPS operates in association with Special Interest Groups (SIGs) covering the areas of drug design and discovery, natural products, formulation design and pharmaceutical technology, translational and personalised medicine, biotechnology, analytical sciences and quality control and regulatory science. A further SIG to cover social and behavioural sciences is in the process of formation. The BPS and its SIGS further their aims by publications, congresses and workshops.

BPS contributes to the programme of the annual FIP World Congress of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences (this year in Dusseldorf) on the basis of ‘science informing practice’, and every 3-4 years it organises the Pharmaceutical Sciences World Congress (PSWC) (the next one is in Stockholm, 2016) as the premier global forum for developments in all aspects of pharmaceutical science. In addition, BPS sponsors scientific workshops, focusing primarily on developing countries and with an emphasis on bioequivalence/biowavers and regulatory sciences.

Through FIPed, BPS also seeks to facilitate global discussion of contemporary challenges in the education of pharmacists and pharmaceutical scientists with respect to undergraduate and graduate curricula and continuing education.
