Based on the "Basic Law for a Gender-Equal Society", the PSJ has initiated the activities on the promotion of gender equality and has dispatched a Declaration on the generation of the Gender-Equal Society in 2016. In the past two annual meetings, the symposia regarding PSJ's organizational approach of the promotion of gender equality were organized, and opinions regarding the present status and challenges on the approach were exchanged.
